Call for Posters

During the last four years, the Human-Agent Interaction Network at the Leibniz-Institut für Wissensmedien explored human interaction with artificial intelligence processing natural language. Eight interdisciplinary projects were carried out in collaboration with researchers from several universities and institutions, e.g., the Universities of Tübingen and Stuttgart and the German Literature Archive Marbach.

After four successful years, we would like to celebrate the completion of these research activities with a concluding conference in Tübingen. The conference aims to bring together experts in the field of human-agent interaction from different areas in a poster session, keynote presentations, and a panel discussion. We are excited to welcome Dr. Minha Lee (Eindhoven Technological University) and Prof. Dr. Nils Köbis (Research Center Trustworthy Data Science and Security) as keynote speakers. A panel discussion with experts on (generative) Al in work, teaching, and everyday life open also for the general public will conclude the conference.

The poster session will provide insights into current research on the perception, use, and impact of language-based Al agents and similar technologies. We invite researchers from Psychology, Communication Science, and related fields working on this or a related topic to submit their work for an on-site poster presentation in Tübingen. Abstracts (300 words max, excluding tables, figures, and references) should briefly address (1) the theoretical background, (2) the research questions, (3) the method, and (4) the results. All submissions will be reviewed according to their theoretical foundation, relevance, appropriateness of the method, and clarity of content.
